Knights await roaring Lions

Gujarat Lions will look to bounce back from their heaviest defeat this season as they take on Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) in the Indian Premier League (IPL) game here on Thursday.

Regular captain Suresh Raina will be back for the tie at the Green Park stadium to boost the team's confidence after skipping the Royal Challengers Bangalore match to be alongside his pregnant wife who gave birth to a daughter recently. It was Raina's first IPL match missed since 2008.

On the contrary the Knights may have to go into this game without their star all rounder Andre Russell who suffered a hamstring pull in the last game.

KKR have 7 wins from 12 outings so far and if they grab all two points against Gujarat they will be almost sure of a play-off spot. The Lions also have as many wins as KKR but they have a lesser net run-rate.

Both teams come into the encounter after being battered by the Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB). First it was the Lions who faced the wrath of the Virat Kohli led side suffering a humiliating 144-run defeat last Saturday.

Twin centuries from Kohli and AB de Villiers helped their side reach a mammoth 248/3 and then RCB bowled Gujarat out for a paltry 104. KKR were then handed a 9-wicket thrashing.

Gujarat know they have to pull up their socks in the next tie. Raina's return can be a boon

for the home side as he has been prolific over the last nine seasons of the league.

And if the likes of Brendon McCullum, Dwayne Smith and Aaron Finch fire, the rival bowlers will have a tough time. The last time these two sides had met at the Eden Gardens, the Lions had come out on top and it will be interesting to see what Gautam Gambhir will do

to turn the tables this time around.

The home side might look to get in Dale Steyn and James Faulkner in the side to strengthen their bowling. The wily fast bowlers might prove to be handy against the in form KKR batsmen. The Knights have suffered problems in their top order but they have been able to put healthy totals on the board frequently.

They will want middle order batsman Yusuf Pathan to fire if they are to score heavily. However, the void left by Russell

may be difficult to fill. Spinners have been the main weapon of the Knights this season but the Green Park strip may not offer much to the likes of Piyush Chawla and Sunil Narine.

VIRAT-GAYLE STORM AT BENGALURU

Skipper smashes fourth ton of tournament, hits 113 off 50 balls; Gayle slams 73 off 32

Virat Kohli battled immense physical pain to script yet another magnificent century to power Royal Challengers Bangalore to an imposing 211 for 3 against bottom-placed Kings XI Punjab in a rain-truncated IPL clash here on Wednesday.

Kohli (113 off 50 balls) notched up his fourth century in the ongoing IPL season and also became the only batsman to score more than 800 runs in a single edition. His tally stands at 865 runs from 13 matches.

The RCB skipper blasted 12 fours and eight sixes as he piled 96 runs in 20 scoring strokes, while his opening partner Chris Gayle smashed a scintillating 32-ball 73 with the help of four boundaries and eight sixes.

The duo butchered the Kings XI Punjab bowlers with a whirlwind 147-

run opening stand to lay the foundation for a huge score.

Earlier, with heavy rain delaying the start, the match was reduced to a 15-over affair and Kings XI Punjab skipper Murali Vijay won the toss and elect-

ed to bowl.

The RCB skipper reached his fifty in 28 balls and alongwith Gayle brought up the team hundred in 8.5 overs at the M Chinnaswamy Stadium.

Gayle reached his 50 off 26 balls in the ninth over with the help of a flat six off Axar Patel over deep midwicket. However, he was dismissed in the 11th over when he was caught by David Miller at long-off.

Four balls later, AB de villiers (0) was sent back to the pavilion by Kyle Miller when the South African was trying to make room to play a shot only to end up dragging it back onto the stumps.

In the 14th over, Kohli blasted Sharma for a six and a four before another attempt to sent him out of the park ended with a mishit, which was safely caught by Miller at long-off.

At the time of going into print, KXIP were 85/7 chasing 212 to win.

Kaushal Silva has urged Sri Lanka to fill the void left by Mahela Jayawardene and Kumar Sangakkara when they return to the scene of one their greatest triumphs for the first Test against England at Headingley on Thursday.

Two years ago, Yorkshire's headquarters ground was the stage where Sri Lanka clinched a dramatic victory off the penultimate ball to secure their first Test series win in England.

But their first tour of England since that campaign sees them without Sangakkara and Mahela, both now retired from international duty.

"We did well here," said Silva, an opening batsman who played in that victorious 2013 team, at Headingley on Tuesday.

"We were thrilled with that, but this is a new series. Sanga and Mahela have left now. So it's time for all these youngsters to take their responsibility and do their jobs."

"We need to make sure we put up at least 300 ... To put ourselves in the game."

Sri Lanka will also be without injured pacer Dhammika Prasad, whose five second-innings wickets played a key role in the tourists' 2014 victory at Headingley.

"He is one of the key bowlers, and obviously we'll miss him," said Silva ahead of the three-Test series.

"But we have other very talented bowlers," he added of an attack that also includes Suranga Lakmal and Nuwan Pradeep, as well as the decidedly sharp Dushmantha Chameera.

Sri Lanka will again be captained by Angelo Mathews, with the all-rounder's excellent hundred paving the way for their success at Headingley two years ago.

The once feared pitch at Headingley, in Leeds,

northern England, is now generally a good surface to bat on, albeit one with pace and bounce, and overhead conditions largely determine how much assistance a seam attack will receive.

Yorkshire coach Jason Gillespie said it was important bowlers avoided a "pretty length".

"Sometimes if fast bowlers see the ball whizzing through to the keeper at chest height a bit of ego then comes into play," the former Australia quick told the Sunday Times.

"It is that 'pretty length'. It looks good but it is actually challenging the batsmen and putting him under pressure?"

Hampshire batsman James Vince is set to make his Test bow, following the enforced retirement of James Taylor with a heart condition, in a batting line-up featuring Joe Root — recently crowned England's player of the year in all formats — and Yorkshire colleague Jonny Bairstow.

England captain Alistair Cook needs just 36 more runs to become the first Englishman to reach 10,000 in Tests.

By contrast, Alex Hales, Cook's opening partner, and number three Nick Compton both go into the match badly needing rather larger scores to cement their places.

"There is a bit of revenge to be had," said Broad, reflecting on a 2014 series which saw Cook, severely criticised for tactical naivety, contemplate resigning the England captaincy after the Headingley defeat by Sri Lanka.

"It was quite an emotional series, it really hurt us as a team to lose in our own conditions."

Today's match is set to break fresh ground by being the first in men's cricket where a new points system, modelled on the one used by England and Australia for the women's Ashes, will be employed.

In a bid to provide further "context", the results of all the international fixtures this season between England and Sri Lanka will be put together to produce an overall winner.

SL TO HONOUR LANDSLIDE VICTIMS

Sri Lanka will pay tribute to all those who have lost their lives in landslides that have rocked the nation when they face England today.

Rescue workers on Wednesday recovered the bodies of 17 villagers buried in landslides in Sri Lanka after three days of torrential rain.

The disaster hit two small villages in Kegalle, and takes the overall death toll from flooding and landslides in recent days to 36.

SC averts possible threat to Thakur

The Supreme Court on Wednesday averted a possible threat to the elevation of BJP MP Anurag Thakur (in pic) as chief of Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) by refusing to hear a petition to stall the election scheduled on Sunday.

Thakur, who is a BJP MP from Hamirpur is tipped to become the BCCI chief after the exit of Shashank Manohar who recently stepped down. But challenging his elevation from Secretary to President, Cricket Association of Bihar came complaining to the apex court alleging that Thakur was unfit for the top cricketing post due to a pending criminal charge accusing him of encroaching land for purpose of cricket stadium at Dharamsala in HP.

The Vacation Bench of Justices Abhay Manohar Sapre and Ashok Bhushan refused to entertain the urgent request by CAB counsel suggesting that the matter should be heard by the special bench headed by Chief Justice of India (CJI) TS Thakur, which is seized of the case relating to reforms in BCCI. The order came as a relief to Thakur as the special bench comprising CJI and Justice FM Ibrahim Kalifulla is likely to be constituted only after the Court reopens by June-end.

CAB in its petition informed the Court that Thakur's elevation would go contrary to the reforms proposed by the Justice RM Lodha Committee to Reform BCCI which specifically bars charge-sheeted persons from assuming top post in BCCI. The petition cited details of a case of cheating and misappropriation filed in August 2013 by the State Anti-Corruption Bureau against Thakur as head of the Himachal Pradesh Cricket Association (HPCA).

The case related to irregularities in allotment of land for construction of a residential complex for cricket players situated three kilometers from Dharamsala stadium. However, the land was allegedly used to build a five star hotel. Presently, the Supreme Court has stayed trial proceedings in the case involving charges under IPC and Prevention of Corruption Act. The stay came on Thakur's petition alleging vendetta against him by the state Chief Minister Virbhadra Singh who is his political bete noire.
