In poll mode SP chief asks party cadres to stop land-grabbing

Samajwadi Party chief Mulayam Singh Yadav on Friday asked some tough questions from the party cadres as to when they will stop land grabbing, minting money and overcome their other weaknesses.

"If you are so fond of money, then politics is not your cup of tea, you should do some business where you can earn more money. Only those people can survive in politics who have the spirit to serve people as public life demands high levels of accountability", said Mulayam Singh Yadav.

Addressing a meeting of the party leaders and cadre on the occasion of 84th birth anniversary of the socialist leader Janeshwar Mishra here on

Wednesday, Mulayam Singh Yadav said "You are dreaming of being voted back to power in 2017 while continuing your old habits of land grabbing and several other illegal activities". On several occasions in last four years and recently in July, he had warned the cadres and leaders to refrain from indulging in illegal activities or they will be shown the door. "All of you are far more interested in sycophancy and keep making rounds of my house and other leaders. Instead of this, you better stop land grabbing and minting money and do the political work as you will get the party ticket only with my signature", said the SP chief adding "Party will have to focus special attention on the youth, farmers and women if you wish to

be voted back to power in 2017."

Taking to task CM Akhilesh Yadav, he said "Party leaders, MLAs and Ministers are complacent about the next Assembly elections and there seems to be no sense of urgency for preparing for the next elections". He, however, added "even if all other parties join hand, SP will form the next Government in UP.

"Leaders of all other parties-the BJP, BSP and even the Congress-are working hard at the grass root level for the next Assembly polls as their cadres have fanned out to the remote areas and villages. Where do we stand as compared to the hard work being done by the other political parties? If you do not get your acts together than there is no hope for the SP in 2017 assembly elections", said Mulayam Singh Yadav in a terse message to his party leader.

Chargesheet filed against Chhota Rajan, Rattesar

J DEY MURDER CASE

Ten months after he was deported from Indonesia, the CBI on Friday filed a charge-sheet against Rajendra Sadashiv Nikalje alias Chhota Rajan and his accomplice Ravi Ram Rattesar in the much-discussed J Dey murder case.

In a supplementary charge-sheet filed in the J Dey murder case before a Special Maharashtra Control of Organised Crime Act (MCOCA) court here, the CBI charged Chhota Rajan and Rattesar under 302 (murder), 34 (crime done in furtherance of common intention) 120-B (conspiracy), 201 (disappearance of evidence) of Indian Penal Code, sections 3, 25, 27 of Arms Act; 37 (1) (a), 135 of Bombay Police Act; Section 3 (1) (i), 3 (2), 3 (4) of MCOCA Act 1999.

3 chained kids rescued from madrasa in Bengaluru

Three kids who were chained inside a madrasa for not attending the class have been rescued in Bengaluru recently. Based on a secretly shot video which went viral on social media, Bengaluru police raided the madrasa in HSR Layout and rescued the siblings and sent them to juvenile home. The eldest among them is just 10 years on Friday. According to police sources, the kids had refused to attend the classes and with consent of the father the teacher chained them and kept them inside the madrasa.

According to MB Boralingaiah, deputy commissioner of police, southeast division confirmed the incident and said three kids (aged 10,

eight and seven) were rescued from a madrasa. He said teacher with the consent of father of the kids had chained them. "We have booked father, Siraj Wahab, a laborer aged around 35, and the teacher Mubarak Moulasaab, 30, on various acts of IPC. But we have got the bail and arrested them. However, we are going to file charge sheet and continue investigation," he added.

According to Krupa, a chairperson of the Karnataka State Commission for Protection of Child Rights, the kids are in trauma. She said this is the first such incident in Bengaluru. She confirmed that there was no sign of any physical abuse on the children.
